BC Trails Day is part of the international celebration of Trails Day on the first Saturday of June. BC Trails Day serves to foster awareness about responsible recreation and environmental stewardship while promoting access to and enjoyment of our province's outdoor spaces.

The Outdoor Recreation Council of BC coordinates and promotes BC Trails Day. in 2023 there were over 80 events, covering every region of the province. Events included clean ups, recreational activities, trail stewardship projects and more.














WHY WE CELEBRATE

Trails are essential to most outdoor recreation activities. 70% of people in British Columbia and millions of visitors participate in outdoor recreation in B.C. every year.

Trail stewards and outdoor recreation groups are the reason many trails continue to exist. BC is home to an estimated 44,000 km of trails. Every year, trail stewards maintain a minimum of 8500 km of trail and they contribute over 100,000 volunteer hours.
